



Statement of Boarding Principles and Practice 2022

- To provide a safe and secure environment that will assist pupils to develop independence and self-resilience whilst following the school values of Valuing Self and Others
- All members of the Boarding House to treat each other with dignity and respect, to be understanding and respond to the needs of others as well as their own
- To provide an environment where the differences between pupils are celebrated and where the aim is to ensure that no pupil is disadvantaged for any reason
- Although living together, staff and boarders to acknowledge the right of each other to privacy
- To encourage pupils to learn to develop friendships outside of their year groups and to build on their relationships with their peers
- To increase pupils' confidence, to allow their personal leadership skills to develop and enhance their wellbeing
- All members of the boarding community, including pupils, to have the opportunity to discuss and help formulate decisions within the Boarding House
