

(Extra 100 grams of milk or white chocolate as topping – if you want)




# Method

#### <u>Barn owl</u>



A very pale, slender owl, typically white on the underparts and golden-brown with grey markings on the upperparts. It has a white, heart-shaped facial disk with dark eyes.

In flight, often gives the impression of a large white bird. Most often seen at dawn and dusk.

## <u>Little owl</u>



A small, compact owl with a rather flattened crown. The facial disk is greyish brown with prominent whitish eyebrows' that give it a stern expression. The eyes are yellow.

Hunts by swooping down from a perch but will also run across the ground in pursuit of prey. Most active at dawn and dusk.

#### Tawny owl

Tawny owls have classic owl features, with a rounded head, large dark eyes and a hooked beak. They have a compact, powerful build with browngrey feathers.

The typical lifespan of the tawny owl in the wild is 4 years. The oldest wild tawny owl ever recorded lived 21 years and 5 months.


